The Executive Director is based in Calgary, but the position is open to anyone living in Alberta. Some onsite activities will be needed, which requires the ability to travel.

Reporting to the Executive Director, the Safe & Welcoming Coordinator (SWC) is responsible for supporting current and future programs in the safety and sport-for-all portfolio.

- Collaboration with partners such as clubs, disciplines, Spirit North, and Canoe Kayak Canada
- Whitewater Leadership Symposium coordination
- Grant writing and/or grant accountability
