### **POSITION OVERVIEW:**

The Alberta Whitewater Association (AWA) is seeking an outstanding candidate to provide leadership and assume responsibility, for coordinating a River Safety Initiative for the province.

### **BACKGROUND:**

Established in 1972, Alberta Whitewater Association is the Provincial Sport Organization dedicated to supporting whitewater sport and recreation in Alberta. Our vision is Exceptional Whitewater & Paddle Sports Experiences. With 20 clubs around the province, three discipline specific organizations and many partners, AWA seeks to build a safe and welcoming sport for all.

The Executive Director is based in Calgary, but the position is open to anyone living in Alberta. Some onsite activities in Calgary will be needed, which may require the ability to travel.

### RIVER SAFETY PROGRAM COORDINATOR POSITION SUMMARY:

Reporting to the Executive Director, the River Safety Program Coordinator (RSPC) is responsible for supporting current and future programs in the river safety portfolio.

Specific responsibilities include:

- 1. Development of an online river safety program
- 2. Development of a river SUP awareness campaign
- 3. Coordination of a PFD lending station at Harvie Passage, including education summer staff oversight
- Collaboration with partners such as clubs, businesses and other organizations to execute the three key initiatives
- Grant writing and/or grant accountability

- Working within a budget to develop and facilitate engagement and collaborative opportunities between community leaders, club administrators, commercial members, and recreational area operators
- Refining and adjusting program designs in response to community needs
- Ensuring the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) & Canoe Kayak Canada education program methodology is integrated into the program
- Meeting AWA reporting requirements
- Working with the AWA team and community members to coordinate and lead special events and communicate these externally.

- Ability to convey, listen to and interpret safety information and opinions of diverse audiences with professionalism and sensitivity
- Ability to show personal leadership within the position, through goal setting, delegating work and meeting timelines consistently

The ideal candidate will live in Alberta. All work-related travel will be covered. A variety of home-base locations will be considered, and flexible working arrangements can be made. This position will require some travel.
